Local Transportation Information for WTDGC 2024

Participants

Mundaring, located approximately **40 minutes east of Perth**, offers several transportation options to help participants and visitors reach the event venue at the **Mundaring Sporting Club**. Whether you're traveling from Perth or nearby areas, this guide provides detailed information on how to get to and from the event using public transport, car hire, ride-share services, and more.

Public Transport

Perth has a reliable and well-connected public transportation system, primarily operated by **Transperth**. The two main forms of public transport you'll likely use are **trains** and **buses**.

Trains

- **Midland Line:** The closest major train station to Mundaring is **Midland Station**, which is on the Midland Line. Trains run frequently between **Perth CBD (Perth Station)** and Midland. The journey from Perth to Midland takes about **30 minutes**.

- **Connecting to Mundaring:** Once you reach **Midland Station**, you'll need to take a bus or taxi to Mundaring, as there is no direct train service to the town itself.

Buses

- **From Midland Station to Mundaring:**
 - **Bus Route 320:** This bus travels from Midland to Mundaring. The journey takes about **35-40 minutes**, and buses run regularly throughout the day.

- **Bus Route 321:** This bus also connects Midland to Mundaring but operates on a slightly different route, offering an alternative option depending on your schedule.

Car Hire and Driving

For those who prefer flexibility, renting a car may be the most convenient option, especially if you're traveling with equipment or a group.

- **City Locations:** Rental offices are also available throughout Perth city.
- **Driving in Australia:**
 - **Left-Hand Driving:** Australia drives on the **left-hand side** of the road.
 - **Traffic Laws:** Familiarize yourself with local traffic laws. Speed limits are generally **50 km/h** in urban areas and up to **110 km/h** on highways.
 - **International Driving Permit:** If you're an international visitor, check if you need an **International Driving Permit (IDP)** in addition to your valid driver's license.

Parking

Mundaring Sporting Club:

- **Parking Availability:** There is ample parking available at the Sporting Complex adjacent to the venue. Parking at the venue will be limited to VIPS, WFDF & LOC, Volunteers only, participants will be directed to park at the sporting complex.
- **Parking Fees:** Parking is generally **free**, but be sure to follow any local signs regarding restrictions.

Taxi and Ride-Share Services

Taxis and ride-share services are readily available in Perth and can be a convenient way to get to Mundaring if you don't want to drive or take public transport.

- **Estimated Costs:**
 - A taxi ride from Perth CBD to Mundaring will take about **40 minutes**, and costs can vary based on distance and time of day. Expect to pay around **AUD \$80-\$100**.

Cycling

For participants who enjoy cycling, Mundaring is accessible via bike, especially for those staying in nearby areas.

- **Car Rental Insurance:** When renting a car, ensure you have adequate insurance coverage.
 - **Insurance Options:** Most car rental companies offer insurance options at the time of booking.
- **International Visitors:** Check with your travel insurance provider to ensure you're covered for any potential damages or accidents.
